Father's Day History

On July 5, 1908, a West Virginia church sponsored an event in memory of and to honor the 362 fathers who had died in the previous December's explosions at the Fairmont Coal Company mines in Monogah, WV. This was a one-time commemoration. The following year, Sonora Smart Dodd from Spokane, WA, one of six children raised by a widower, tried to establish an event equivalent to Mother's Day for fathers. And she was successful. Father's Day was first celebrated in the U.S. on June 19, 1910 in Washington state. It wasn't until 1966 when President Lyndon Johnson signed a Presidential declaration announcing the 3rd Sunday of June as Father's Day. In 1972, President Richard Nixon established a permanent national observance of Father's Day to be held on the third Sunday of June.
