

As many of you know, the United States has had an outbreak of the COVID-19, also known as the Coronavirus Disease 2019. We are asking that visitation of your loved ones be limited during this time. This means we ask that you do not visit your loved one at this time, unless an emergent situation arises such as end of life crisis. If these situations arise, we are requesting families to contact the Administrator or Director of Nursing by phone to discuss options/make arrangements for visitation. We have also asked families not to come to the facility if they are experiencing respiratory symptoms such as cough, fever, sore throat; if they have been exposed to someone who has these symptoms within the last 14 days or if they have traveled outside of the country in the last three weeks. We have been in contact with the Iowa Department of Public Health and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, who have recommended we take these precautions in order to protect your loved ones.
